PRO-D DDAY Registration Forms

Attached to this newsletter you will find a registration form that allows you to register your child for our pro-d day programs for the school year. Registration forms must be completed and handed in with postdated cheques otherwise your child will not be registered for the pro-d days. We register on a first come first serve basis and will fill up fast. We will only be running two programs per day. If at any point during the year you need to withdraw your child from a registered pro-d day, you must fill out a Change in Registration/Withdrawal Form and give one month's notice for reimbursement of fees. Registration begins on Tuesday September 5th. We have increased our Pro D Day fees this year to \$40.00 per day for registered families and \$45.00 per day for non-registered children. We run camps from 7:30 AM—5:30 PM.
